



**Winner:** Photographer **Caio A. Figueiredo de Andrade** found this amazing *Stenocercus dumerilii* scurrying on the ground, during a fieldtrip in the Brazilian Amazon, near Bom Jesus das Selvas, Maranhão. It is a beautiful and calm lizard, endemic to Brazil, and so little-known that it is rated as 'data deficient' by the IUCN. This species appears to not cope well in modified environments, and habitat loss may lead to its extinction.
