

Amphibian Week Sample Proclamation

A great way to raise awareness about amphibians is to get your state to officially recognize Amphibian Week through a proclamation! Generally, it takes a minimum of 30 days to request a proclamation from your Governor. Feel free to use and/or modify the sample text below.

WHEREAS, the State of [Your State] recognizes the vital role that amphibians play in maintaining ecological balance and contributing to the rich biodiversity of our shared ecosystems; and

WHEREAS, amphibians, including frogs, toads, salamanders, and newts, are essential indicators of the health of our water, wetlands, and ecosystems; and
